About us

Our Victim Help Team, along with our outreach staff are trained to give free and confidential information and support to victims of crime. They help people make sense of what they've been through, tell them about the choices they can make and help them get their lives back under control again.

Who we support

The North Wales Victim Help Centre is here to help anyone affected by crime, not only victims, but their friends, family and any other people involved. We support victims of every type of crime.

The crime doesn't have to be recent. If you were a victim of crime historically, we will still be here for you.

The Victim Help Centre will also support young victims of crime, under 18 years old.

Services we can provide

- Emotional support – we are here to listen.
- Practical support – such as applying for Criminal Injuries Compensation and securing your home
- Information and signposting to specialist agencies and support
- Advocacy – act as your voice with agencies
- Criminal justice process – helping you to understand your rights under the Victims Code and supporting you throughout the Criminal Justice Process if your case goes to Court.
- Case workers – we have a dedicated mental health and wellbeing case worker as well as a Hate Crime case worker who can provide the right support to stop you feeling isolated and frightened and can provide you with assistance in reporting a crime and attending court.



We are an independent service and you can talk to us whether or not you reported the crime to the police.
