

The Law and Hate Crime

In England and Wales the monitored strands of hate crime are:

- racially and religiously aggravated;
- homophobic, biphobic and transphobic; and
- disability hate crime.

These strands are covered by legislation (sections 28-32 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 and sections 145 and 146 of the Criminal Justice Act 2003) which allows prosecutors to apply for an increase in sentence for those convicted of a hate crime.



- Yn 2021, graddiodd **94%** o'r cyfranogwyr y sesiynau fel 'Rhagorol' neu 'Da lawn' a nododd cyfranogwyr bod ganddynt fwy o hyder wrth fynd i'r afael â hiliaeth yn y gofod addysg.
- Meithrin hyder cyfranogwyr wrth fod yn wrth-hiliol rhagweithiol

INITIAL TEACHER TRAINING

- Since starting this project prior to 2010, we have worked with at least **4572 students** on ITT and Education programmes in both Welsh and English
- We work with **7 universities** across Wales
- In 2021, **94%** of participants rated the sessions 'Excellent' or 'Very Good' and reported increased confidence in tackling racism in the education space.
- Builds participant confidence in being pro-actively anti-racist
- Equips participants with the tools to act decisively and effectively if racism does occur
- Gives participants the opportunity to share their own experiences, reflect, and learn from each other
- Signals that the funder and the university take an anti-racist stance







Professional learning for those working in education to develop an understanding and development of anti-racist practice


Our vision is to ensure that those working within education develop the tools and carry out anti-racist practice that supports the aim of being an anti-racist Wales by 2030.

What led you to set up Show Racism the Red Card?


